

Approved Minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – April 14, 2010

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township Board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, April 14, 2010. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Audience: Don Nagel and John Lindahl.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Members present – Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Tom Giles, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen to approve the minutes of the March meeting as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: None

The Treasurer's report was read. A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod, to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by McKellips, we pay the bills as presented. Roll Call Vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Checks 7841 – 7890 Total Disbursements: \$ 21,671.29

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board stated that the meeting last month was short. Medicaid reimbursement will be cut again. This is the last year of the contract and with a new contract next year there will be an increase. Interest earned will not take care of expenses like it used to in the past. There are no changes with AMR to report. Things are running smoothly and the building is kept very nice. There was discussion on the cost of an ambulance ride. Costs vary according to the severity of the health issue. There was also some discussion on the advertised Ambu-care insurance that is available for \$40.00 per year through the end of April.

Bernie McLeod, Transfer Station Custodian, reported that he had a meeting last Thursday and the discussion was about the Fennville School canceling the recycling program with Ray D.

New Business: Discussion of the proposed ordinance to add Wind Tower Language; add protect natural resources language. A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod that we adopt Ordinance # 60 as written. Motion carried.

John Lindahl of the Hutchins Lake Association stated that they will be replacing 2 buoys. The Association will cover the cost for these buoys. The Lake Board Association Special Assessing District group was approved four years ago to collect money to treat weeds in Clyde and Ganges. This is the last year of the approval. A Public Hearing will need to be held to review this Board. There has been some controversy with regard to the lake treatment plant studies.

Supervisor Giles received the Clyde Township Aerial Imagery Disc. Cathy Ptak, Clerk will look into obtaining a print.

Public Comment: Don Nagel commented that area road work has begun. The quality of work and materials is not as good as it used to be. There was agreement on this subject.

No further business. A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, we adjourn.
