The Treasurer's report was read. A motion made by McLeod, supported by McKellips, to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion made by McLeod, supported by Larsen, that we pay the bills as presented. Roll Call Vote - - all yea's. Motion carried.

Rick McKellips reported for the Pearl Cemetery. McKellips reported that the well pump was fixed. It would be cheaper in the future to replace the pump than repair. New pumps are only \$40 - \$50.

Bernie McLeod reported for the Transfer Station. There was discussion of Saturday hours at the Transfer Station. Clyde Township is not in favor of extended hours.

Tom Giles reported that Township Attorney, Roxanne Seeber, would like to also make zoning violations a civil infraction. This would require a Planning Commission meeting and also a public hearing. More information will be forthcoming.
