

Approved Minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – July 14, 2010.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township Board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, July 14, 2010. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Audience: Sarah Bushee, Andy Cook, Dean Kapenga, Rick McKellips, Don Nagel, Robert Sarro, and Joe Schut.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Members present – Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Tom Giles, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen to approve the minutes of the June meeting as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: Sherry Torres of the Allegan County Department of Senior Services sent a letter introducing herself and offering to be a guest speaker for any meeting or event. The Allegan County Department of Senior Services has a Senior Millage on the ballot for the upcoming election. This millage will make it possible for seniors to obtain services to assist them in remaining independent in their homes.

The Treasurer's report was read. A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod, to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now a part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by McKellips, we pay the bills as presented. Roll Call Vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Rick McKellips, Fire Chief reported that they have acquired a 1985 Dodge Crew Cab Truck from the State of MI. This DNR vehicle seats six passengers and runs good. The fire department has another 2 year fire protection agreement with Valley.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board reported there are no changes and work place injury runs are way down. There was money transferred from checking to savings this month to cover some expenses.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station reported that everything is good.

Dean Kapenga, Allegan County Commissioner, introduced Robert Sarro who is a County Administrator. Sarro gave us an overview of the Corrections Center Proposal (Jail). He explained and simplified the ballot language with regard to costs and construction of the building. He also stated that this process will be more of a remodel than construction as the proposed building already exists.

New Business: A motion by McKellips, supported by Larsen, to retain Marlynn Starring as Library Board Trustee for Clyde Township. Motion carried.

No further business. A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, we adjourn.
