

Approved minutes of the Clyde Township Board Meeting – Sept. 14, 2011.

The regular monthly meeting of the Clyde Township Board was held at the Township Hall on Wednesday, September 14, 2011. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Audience: Don Nagel

Roll Call: Members present – Tom Giles, Bob Larsen, Bernie McLeod, Chris McKellips, and Cathy Ptak. All members present.

A motion by McKellips, supported by McLeod, to approve the minutes of the Special Board Meeting held on August 9, 2011 as written. Motion carried.

A motion by McLeod, supported by Larsen, to approve the minutes of the August Board Meeting as written. Motion carried.

Correspondence: The Clyde Township Incident Report was submitted to the supervisor.

The Treasurer's report was presented. A motion by Larsen, supported by McLeod, to approve the Treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried. The report is attached and is now part of the official minutes.

Bills were presented. A motion by McLeod, supported by, McKellips, that we pay the bills as presented. Roll Call Vote – all yea's. Motion carried.

Don Nagel of the Ambulance Board stated that he had a meeting on Sept. 8<sup>th</sup>. This was a short meeting with no major issues. The month of July was the busiest in AMR history. They are working on ideas for fundraisers to acquire updated CPR equipment.

Bernie McLeod of the Transfer Station reported that in December or January there will no longer be a contract with Chef Container. The suggestion is to put this program up for bid. Chef Container has agreed to stay until all bids are in and approved.

Supervisor Giles stated that he believes additional road mowing will be close to \$2,000. Tasha Smalley of Michigan Township Services has notices prepared and ready to mail to those individuals regarding ordinance violations pertaining to horses and acreage. A public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, Sept. 20, 2011.

New Business: Marlynn Starring and Donna Matula were officially sworn in by the Clerk at the Fennville District Library on August 24, 2011.

Public Comments: Don Nagel stated that an Ottawa County Township has done away with their ZBA due to budget cuts. At the present time Supervisor Giles stated there are no plans to do away with the Clyde Township ZBA. Giles commented that he has formed a Bureau of Construction Committee. He has no Clyde members on this committee so there will be no conflict of interest dilemmas. There was some discussion with regard to the Margetson case going to trial.
